

When viewing your exam results you may choose to post on Facebook, LinkedIn, Twitter or WeChat







When viewing your exam results in the Candidate Portal, select the option to 'Create Badge'.



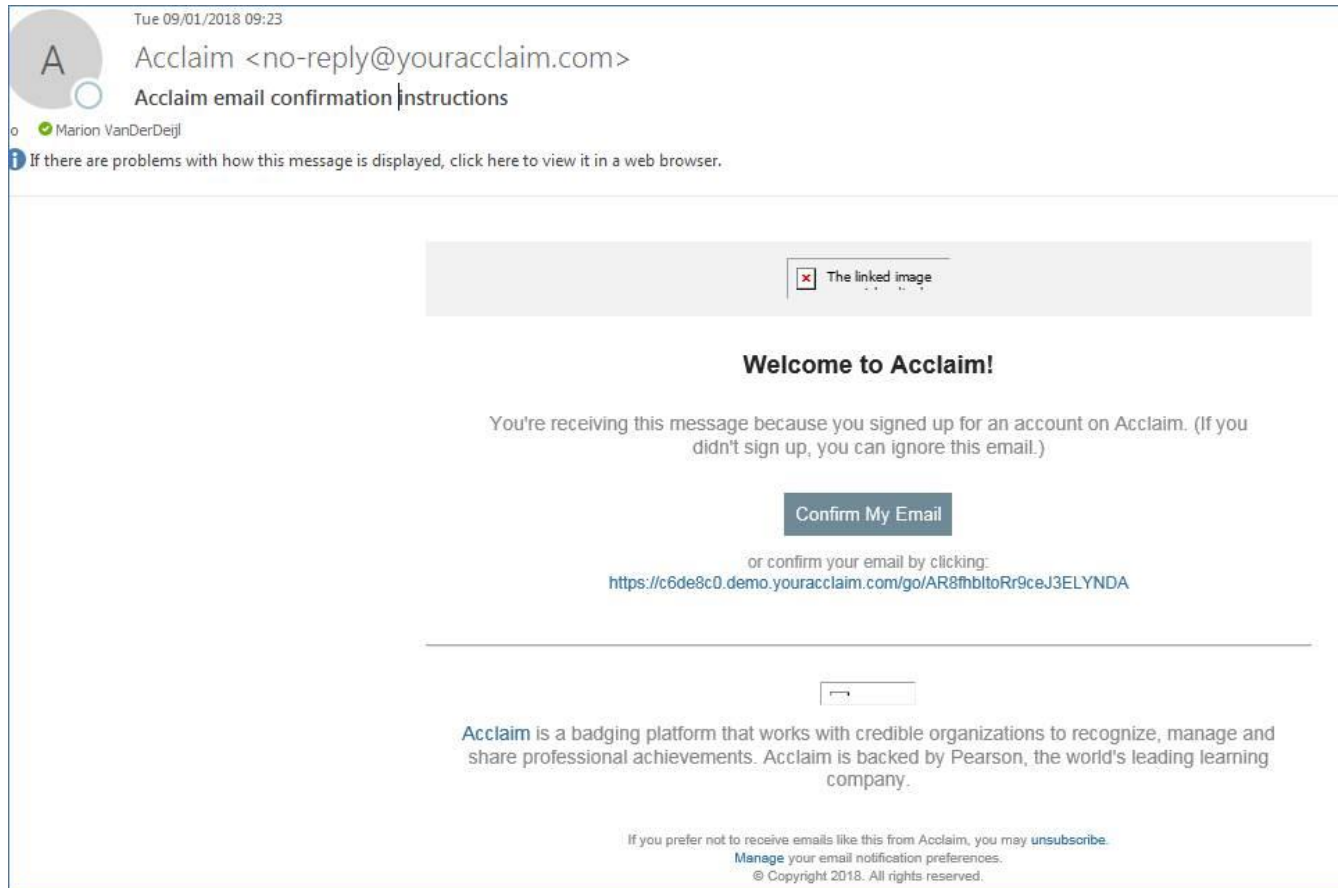
Clicking 'Create Badge' takes you to the Acclaim website, where you will be guided through the process.




